## ABOUT THE DESTINATION

#### Climate

The Laško area is characterised by a temperate continental climate. The winter months are cold, summer brings high temperatures, and the spring and autumn months are moderately warm.

The average January temperature in Laško is around 2°C, while the average July temperature is 19°C. The average annual rainfall is between 1,000 and 1,300mm; the majority of the rain falls in the months of July and November.

Climatic conditions allow for pleasant walks in nature in all seasons!

## LAŠKO – EXPERIENCE OF THERMAL PANNONIAN SLOVENIA

#### Special features of healing waters

Thermal Pannonian Slovenia is an area of healing water springs, excellent spas and wellness centres. There are two verified health resorts in the area of Laško with an exceptional tradition and with the most up-to-date accommodation, bathing, health and wellness facilities. The healing water on which Thermana Laško services are based springs from a depth of 160 metres and has a temperature between 32 and 35°C. In addition to minerals, it is characterised by exceptional biofields. The healing water of the Roman baths with temperatures between 36 and 39°C comes from a depth of as much as 1,000 metres. The waters of Laško have been a source of health and well-being for centuries.

#### Water and beer

In addition to thermal mineral waters, the area also has exceptional sources of drinking water.



Spring water from unspoiled nature is an important ingredient of beer, which has been brewed in Laško since 1825! A trip to the hospitable countryside leads to rivers, streams and waterfalls, which are the living environment of many plant and animal species due to their purity.

#### Bee-keeping and herbalism

Laško is an area of many wild and cultivated herbs. Traditional knowledge is also associated with beekeeping. Laško is one of the most bee-friendly areas in Slovenia.

#### LASKO IN THE LAND OF CELJE

## The grandeur of history and mysteries of the Counts of Celje

The Land of Čelje is a broad area consisting of 21 municipalities spreading from the Savinja Valley to the Obsotelje and Kozjansko regions. This is also an area of castles, associated with the Counts of Celje, the most powerful noble family from Slovenia. A castle

above Laško near their home town of Celje was their hunting mansion, meanwhile the mysterious valley of the Gračnica creek and the Jurklošter Monastery keep the secrets of a love story between Frederick of Celje and Veronica of Desenice.

These stories give a special charm to the area, which was already settled before our times. Here, the Celts and the Romans lived, and at the time of migration of the nations, the Vlachs or Lahi resided here in addition to the Slavs, and this presumably influenced the name of the place. The medieval Laško market was probably founded as early as in the 11th century. It became a large noble location with the seat of the oldest ancient parish in Slovenia.

Laško, which developed in the Middle Ages, gained momentum with the arrival of the railway. In addition to the crafts and industry, and previously mining, both of the spas and a brewery developed. In 1927, on the occasion of the 700th anniversary of the first mention of Laško, Laško was proclaimed a town was under the command of King Alexander I.

#### THREE LILIES OF THE LAŠKO COAT OF ARMS

The Laško coat of arms depicts three silver or white lilies on a blue background and is one of the most interesting coats of arms in Slovenia. Laško received the coat of arms based on a privilege at the end of the 16th century, however its origin and significance remain unclear.

The estate in Laško was owned by the family of Vetter von der Lilie, whose coat of arms depicted three lilies on a blue background, but probably the family took both their coat of arms and the name after Laško. Namely, they bought the estate almost 70 years after Laško received its coat of arms.

Lilies in the Laško coat of arms are reminiscent of the coat of arms of the Bourbons, the French family, which cannot be associated with Laško. In the Middle Ages, lilies were a symbol of purity and chastity, a sign of royal dignity and symbol of the Virgin Mary, in honour of whom several important features were erected in Laško in the Middle Ages. It is possible that the coat of arms is connected with the origin of the parish patron saint, St Martin of Tours, but it can also be only a variation of the coat of arms of the Counts of Celje – three stars on a blue background.

## LAŠKO, AN AREA OF ACCESSIBLE AND GREEN TOURISM

Today, Laško is an attractive tourist area with a health resort and brewery traditions. In 2013, Laško was named a European Destination of Excellence. It won the title with its development of accessible tourism. It is developing according to the principles of sustainable tourism and carries the Slovenia Green Destination Bronze label.

#### LAŠKO FACE-TO-FACE

The Municipality of Laško has approximately 14,000 inhabitants. Hospitable locals are traditionally connected to guests visiting this area. They participate in the lively tourist, cultural and sports pulse of the city with its rich natural and cultural heritage. #### **FISHING ON THE SAVINJA RIVER**

Fishing season: all year round.

Fishing options: huchen, brown trout, pike, zander, catfish, asp, tench, common nase, cactus roach, common chub, common barbel, Danube barbel, vimba bream, common bream, common roach, European perch, common minnow, common bleak, common carp, grass carp, Prussian carp

**Type of fishing:** float fishing, bottom fishing, spin fishing, fly fishing

**Fishing licences:** cyprinids licence, predatory fish licence and huchen licence



#### ATTENTION!

Huchen fishing is only allowed when accompanied by a member of RD Laško. Only artificial baits are allowed.

Maximum daily catch is 1 fish. Maximum catch during the season in the Savinja river basin is 5 fish. In the event of catching a huchen, RD Laško must be notified immediately.

#### FISHING AT THE MAROF POND

**Fishing season:** during weekends and holidays from 1 April to 31 October

**Fishing options:** common carp, grass carp, bighead carp, common nase, common bream, Prussian carp, common chub, common bleak, common roach, pike, zander

**Type of fishing:** float fishing, bottom fishing, spin fishing, fly fishing

**Fishing licences:** special licence for the Marof pond; cyprinids licence, predatory fish licence

**HINT:** next to the pond, there is a fishing cabin and restaurant where they also serve fish; their speciality is trout prepared in the unique Jurklošter fashion.

#### FISHING IN THE GRAČNICA CREEK

Fishing season: from 1 March to 31 August

**Fishing options:** grown trout, common chub, grayling (seldom)

Type of fishing: fly fishing

**Fishing licences:** special licence for the Marof pond; cyprinids licence, predatory fish licence



#### ATTENTION!

The Gračnica creek is an exceptional ecosystem, which is protected by abiding to the fishing rules. Only artificial flies (wet fly, artificial bait dry fly) with bent barb. It is prohibited to use baits such as spinners and bubble floats, and all types of live animals, animals and animal ingredients, which are endangered and protected based on the natural conservation decrees, and any baits that contain toxic chemicals.

#### THE AŠKERC HOMESTEAD

The literary-ethnological collection at the homestead in the hamlet of Senožete presents the life and work of Slovenia's most famous ballad poet. Anton Aškerc. The more than 500-year-old building with black kitchen, the straw-thatched granary and a toplar hayrack uncover the ethnological and architectural heritage of the area. The active homestead also offers home-made sheep cheese tastings.

#### ST MARTIN'S PARISH CHURCH

The bell-tower, the main nave and a specially ribbed vault bear witness to the original design of the church, which began to emerge in the 12th or 13th century. Due to its architectural style known as "the Laško Group", which was first featured in the Carthusian church in Jurklošter, the church, in which ten altars were built during the Baroque period, is one of the most important Romanesque monuments in Slovenia.

#### TABOR CASTLE - PAVUS RESTAURANT


## WORTH VISITING! JURKLOŠTER CARTHUSIAN MONASTERY

## TRIPS AROUND CELJE



Today, Celje is the third largest Slovenian town. Visit the historic city centre, get to know the history of the Counts of Celje and visit the Old Castle on the hill above the city.

There are romantic streets, architecture that shows the richness and liveliness of the past, magnificent building façades, welcoming markets and a wild selection of museum, galleries and theatres.

#### **CELJE CASTLE**

The Old Castle Celje invites you to discover the rich historical heritage of our city and the famous myth of its founders. Bold ancestors, strong personalities marked by an uncompromising desire for power and extraordinary abilities, which enabled them to rise among the most important noble families of their time and finally the decline of a dynasty, broken by a single event — all of this stimulated people's imagination and represented an excellent basis for the creation of a European legend. And it's a true story! In addition to the fact that the Counts of Celje are known throughout Central Europe, a special multi-layered myth about the Counts of Celje developed locally over time, which was impossible to extinguish by even the most critical historical period.

#### **CELJE KOČA**

The Celjska koča (Celje Cottage) ski resort and mountain hut that lays at 650m above sea levels offers recreational activities in natural environment in all seasons. The area around Celje koča is rich with small areas denoted by special natural aspects or cultural heritage: Hudičev Graben Gorge, Grmada nad Pečovnikom with three peaks, Douglas fir groves in Pečovnik, Vipota forest reserve, Trobiš's beech tree (around 200 years old) and the Church of Our Lady of the Snows on Svetina.

## TRIPS AROUND ŽALEC



Welcome to Žalec, where green gold surrounds you! Žalec is full of stories told by nature, and written by man. Set out on their learning paths with a curious mind and visit the dreamy nooks, either alone or in the company. Get to know the karstic jewel in the middle of the Štajerska region – Pekel Cave, or enjoy the oasis of Vrbje Pond, which is a haven for more than 170 species of birds. Due to its position, Žalec has always been an important post, which is reflected in the variety of cultural and historical sights. You can find one of the most important monuments of the Roman period in Slovenia, namely the Roman necropolis in nearby Šempeter. A house in the centre of Žalec that bears the venerable year of 1669 its portal is the birth house of the general and composer Risto Savin. Here, surrounded by green gold and between the hop plantations, there are many opportunities for active leisure time: hiking, climbing, biking, riding horses, fishing, exploring themed and walking routes.

### WORTH VISITING! ŽALEC BEER FOUNTAIN

The Green Gold Fountain is a tribute to the hop-growing heritage of the Lower Savinja Valley and Žalec, which is the hop-growing centre of Slovenia. Slovenia is also the fifth largest producer of hops in the world and hops is the "spice" that gives beer its distinctive flavour.

The beer fountain is positioned in the town park, in the town centre, next to the marketplace. The architectural design is a symbolic hop flower, which is expressed as two semi-circles; one a beer fountain and the other a water fountain. The semi-circles are clad in copper lace, symbolising beer foam.





## ECO-MUSEUM OF HOP-GROWING AND THE BREWING INDUSTRY IN SLOVENIA

The tradition of hop-growing and brewing has been ongoing in this region since 1876.

The central museum, located on the premises of a former hop-drying facility, has four floors. There, visitors can learn about the food, garments, traditions, and numerous hop-related products and tools for the growing and processing hops.

Various events accompany and illustrate the hopgrowing tradition and local folklore: the setting up of hop poles, hop-growers' day, the election of the hop princess and the hop elder, the hop trail hike, and the hop-growers' feast. You can visit the Eco-Museum individually or in a group, buy a souvenir in the museum shop, and later visit the beer tasting room to taste the house beer Kukec – Savinja Valley Beer or taste the customary hoppickers' lunch.



#### **PEKEL CAVE**

Pekel Cave is a karstic jewel in the heart of the Štajerska region. For millions of years, the Ponikvica creek seeped through the calciferous ground and created a magical underground karstic cave in the middle of the Lower Savinja Valley. With a bit of imagination, an image of the Devil himself can be seen above the entrance. In winter, when the external temperature is lower than the temperature in the cave, steam sometimes comes out of the entrance. That is why our ancestors used to be afraid of the cave and named it Pekel (Hell).

A well-protected path past numerous stalactite formations and side tunnels rises all the way towards the 4m high underground waterfall on the Peklenščica creek, which is also the highest underground waterfall in Slovenia. The stairs take us to the upper, dry part, which contains more stalactite formations. The visitor exits the cave through the artificially made exit 42m higher.

Temperature in the cave: 10°C.

Appropriate clothing and shoes are recommended. Visit duration: approximately one hour. You can visit the cave during working hours or based on prior arrangement for groups.



#### **VRBJE POND**

Vrbje pond is a sanctuary for birds – over 170 species have been spotted in the area. The south part of the pond is a Natura 2000 site.

It stretches over 13 hectares and is the largest stagnant water body in this part of the valley. Around Vrbje pond there is an interesting, 3km long Eco-Learning Trail, which can be enjoyed all year round. There are also several other theme trails close to the pond that to partly or all the way along the pond, such as the Hop Trail. You can also admire the open-air gallery with wooden sculptures.

## TRIPS AROUND ŠENTJUR



Šentjur is the home of renowned composers, namely the Ipavec brothers, of the blessed Anton Martin Slomšek, and it is the place of many cultural and natural sights, such as the Rifnik archaeological site, the Museum of the Southern Railway, as well as the European pasqueflower that attracts the attention of every visitor with its silky velvet stalk and incredible purple flowers. It blooms in February, March or April – depending on the weather. It is an endangered and protected species in Slovenia, and here, in Boletina, is one of its few habitats in Europe. There is also the "Kozjansko see" just a few kilometres away, namely the Slivnica Lake, which is a true paradise for nature, fishing and peace lovers.

#### THE IPAVEC FAMILY HOUSE

In the old market town centre, there is the house of the Ipavec family, built in 1760. This legendary lineage from Šentjur went down in history mainly because of their contributions to music and medicine. Today their house holds a permanent exhibition on their life and work. There is a wine cellar with selected wines in the basement and the garden boasts an old lime tree and a well made by the architect Jože Plečnik. In the house there is also a wedding hall and at the entrance portal there is a special vine, 'bleu de Cologne' ("modra kavčina"), which is a graft of the oldest vine in Europe that grows in Lent, Maribor. The Ipavec composers left their mark on music from the 19th and early 20th century. The most famous are the brothers Gustav and Benjamin; the first brother is known for his nationalism-awakening songs, 'Slovenec sem' ("I am a Slovenian"), 'Vse mine' ("Everything Passes"), 'Domovini '("To Homeland") etc., and the second brother is known for his historical opera, 'Teharski plemiči' ("The Noblemen of Teharje") and a stage work, 'Tičnik' ("The Aviary"). Josip Ipavec is known among the musicians as the author of the first Slovene ballet with pantomime, 'Možiček' ("The Little Man") and the operetta, 'Princesa Vrtoglavka' ("The Dizzy Princess").



## BIRTHPLACE OF ANTON MARTIN SLOMŠEK

The blessed Anton Martin Slomšek was born in 1800 in the village Uniše near Ponikva. His place of birth has been restored and can be visited all year round. The exhibition follows the life of the great priest, tutor and national awakener from his early childhood up to the point when he decided to become a priest, followed by episcopacy and eventually beatification in 1999.

#### **SEVNICA AND SEVNICA CASTLE**



#### PTUJ

Ptuj is an old town of new experiences. The castle above the town with the oldest wine cellars watches over the streets with one of the most colourful carnivals in the world and the Kurenti masks, the exceptional character of which has also been recognised by UNESCO. The mighty Drava River and the curvy wine-growing hills create a unique backdrop of the oldest city in Slovenia. On the castle hill, centuries of history are intertwined with the most valuable plant, the vine.



#### **MARIBOR**

Maribor, capital of the Štajerska region and second largest city in Slovenia, offers many sights and attractions that can turn your visit to the city into an experience rich in culture and heritage, an exceptional wine tradition, a cheerful and relaxed pace of events and sporting euphoria. Welcome to the city of the oldest vine in the world and the European Capital of Culture 2012! It is a meeting point for wine and culinary paths, where wine and good food are an important part of urban everyday life.

#### THE ŽIČE CHARTERHOUSE

Where time stands still and nature speaks to us and the cultural heritage is revived. The ground floor of Gastuž was part of the Žiče Charterhouse as early as in 1467. There, they served monastery wine to travellers and today, this is considered to be the oldest inn in Slovenia. In the arched cellars of the Žiče Carthusian monastery, founded by the margrave Ottokar in the 12th century, 60,000 bottles of white and rosé sparkling wine are being matured. In the Žiče Charterhouse, you can feel the peace that the Carthusian monks once lived in...



#### **ZLATI GRIČ**

Boasting one of the most modern wineries in the Štajerska region, a golf course and apartments in the Winegrowers's Mansion from the 15th century, Zlati Grič is truly one of its hidden gems. In the heart of the vineyards lies one of the most modern wine cellar in the region. The building with an area of 3,500 square metres and a capacity of 1.3mio. litres is fully underground. Not far from here, you can find...

#### **TIMBER RAFT CRUISES ON THE SAVA RIVER**

Lively river traffic always took place on the Sava River and Radeče was the main port on this route. Therefore, the town's history has always been closely linked to timber rafting. For 500 years, the activity provided many locals the opportunity to lead decent lives. And even though the profession itself was demanding, it was a highly respected one. Since they sailed down the rivers Savinja, Sava and Danube all the way to Belgrade and even further to the Black Sea, their work was of course dangerous. With the arrival of the railways rafting slowly started to die out, but despite that the rafters' tradition, habits and customs left an indelible mark on the region.

You are very welcome to join us in the period from April to October.

We will take you on a two-hour timber raft experience on the Sava river. Stories, local music and dances will reveal what harsh lives the raftsmen led and which merry habits they had. You will also take part in an authentic rafters' christening.



#### **LOGAR VALLEY**

It is one of the most beautiful alpine glacial valleys in Europe. You can relax in the peaceful surroundings of the landscape park and enjoy in hiking, cycling, and riding.

#### **EXPERIENCE THE DOLENJSKA REGION**

This land of a special wine called cviček is also famous for its romantic hills, vineyards, castles, warm rivers and excellent culinary delicacies. Nowhere else will you find so many vineyard cottages, vineyard sheds and cellars in such a small area as in the Dolenjska region and Bela krajina region in the south of Slovenia. According to some records, there are around 15.000 of them.



#### **VELIKA PLANINA**

This magical plateau with one of the largest herdsmen's settlements in Europe invites you to learn about the fascinating life on the mountain pasture and sample the dairy goodies they will prepare for you.



#### VINARIUM LENDAVA

Sightseeing in the Prekmurje region starts with Vinarium Lendava. When was the last time you were able to see the landscapes of four different countries at once? The watchtower Vinarium Lendava, standing 53.5 metres tall, offers an incredible 360° view of the colourful landscape that stretches from the settlement of Lendavske gorice, where the tower proudly stands, all the way to the river basin of Mura, and encompasses a wonderful view of the plains and hills of Slovenia, Hungary, Croatia, and Austria. You can reach the highest platform of the tower by a comfortable ride with the elevator or by climbing 240 steps, where you will then experience the most beautiful vantage point.
